RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the daughter of Mary Cruz has brought to the attention of the Tribal Council her elderly mother's need for bladework around her homesite area in Seven-Mile; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Cruz's daughter also has brought to the attention of the Tribal Council the encroachment of neighbors on Mary Cruz's homesite area and the unauthorized moving of the fence line.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Development Enterprise is hereby directed to use its equipment to blade and level the homesite area of Mary Cruz; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Raymus Albert is hereby directed to look into the matter of unauthorized moving of the fence and encroachment on the homesite of Mary Cruz.

The foregoing resolution was on April 11, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (h) and (m) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
