RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Representatives of the Headstart Program have brought to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe the planned activity of the Headstart Program for the 25th Anniversary Celebration of the Headstart Program; and
- WHEREAS, the celebration includes a rodeo and other activities; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been requested to donate \$675.00 (Six Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars) for the purchase of a saddle to be given away in the rodeo; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council believes it to be in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Council support fully the Headstart activities.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that \$675.00 is hereby authorized to be donated to the Headstart Program for the purchase of a trophy saddle to be given away during the 25th Headstart Rodeo Celebration; said funds to come from the Tribal Council appropriations.

The foregoing resolution was on April 11, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
