## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that gasoline storage tanks exist underground at the old gas station site in McNary; and
- WHEREAS, said gasoline storage tanks are potentially hazardous to the community, the general public and the water supply in the area; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe said storage tanks be removed.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Ray Ivans as Safety Director is hereby directed to take appropriate actions to ensure that the gasoline tanks underground at McNary are properly removed; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Ray Ivans work with the Engineering Department who has been looking at the issue of underground storage tanks and work with Woody's Petroleum for removal.

The foregoing resolution was on April 11, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
