- WHEREAS, Alvin Declay, District III Community President has brought to the attention of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe the need for a pay phone at the convenience store at Seven-Mile Community; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believes it to be in the best interest of the community that a pay phone be installed at the convenience store.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby directs that communication be made
 with Contel through the Office of the Chairman for the
 purpose of obtaining installation of a pay phone at the
 Seven-Mile Convenience Store.

The foregoing resolution was on April 11, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
