RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe will benefit if members of the Tribal Council are able to devote themselves fulltime to their responsibilities of identifying community problems and recommending legislative solutions thereto and to otherwise fulfill their responsibilities set forth in the Tribal Constitution to protect the health, education, welfare and safety of tribal members and property; and
- WHEREAS, the duties and responsibilities of the Tribal Council may best be served by placing Tribal Council Members on full-time Council pay so that Council Members may devote fulltime to their legislative and community responsibilities; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Tribal Council members Randall Massey, Jr., Kino Kane, Virgil Hinton, Nashley Tessay, Sr., Matthew Nozie, should receive Council compensation in the amount of \$20,900.00 per annum.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby places Council Members Randall Massey, Jr., Kino Kane, Virgil Hinton, Nashley Tessay, Sr., and Matthew Nozie on a full-time council status with compensation of \$20,900.00, this resolution to be effective this date.

The foregoing resolution was on May 8, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) (s) (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
