RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has requested that the Bureau of Indian Affairs transfer five mobile homes located at the Cibecue Community School that have been previously declared unsafe and in excess of the needs of the Bureau of Indian Affairs by the Fort Apache Agency; and
- WHEREAS, the Agency has advised the Tribal Council that the trailers may be transferred to the White Mountain Apache Tribe under the authority of 25 USC Section 443 (a) only upon compliance and submission of all requirements set forth in 43 BIAM Supplement 2, and other applicable provisions of the BIAM; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Tribe may request a waiver of BIAM requirements and those required in 25 USC section 443 (a).
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs transfer title and ownership of the five mobile homes located at the Cibecue Community School to the Tribe and that the Bureau waive any requirements set forth in 43 BIAM Supplement 2, et seq.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in the event said waiver is not granted that the Bureau notify the Tribal Chairman's office immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of \underline{six} for and \underline{zero} against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
