RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by Rev. Arthur Guenther that retired trader Johnny Lee passed away and that in his last will and testament he requested that he be buried at the Whiteriver Cemetery on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation with Tribal Council approval; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Arthur Guenther has come before the Tribal Council and communicated Johnny Lee's last wishes and his request for Tribal Council permission to be buried at the Whiteriver Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Arthur Guenther advises the Tribal Council that if the Tribal Council grants approval of Mr. Lee's last wish that Mr. Lee be buried in the Guenther family plot; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Mr. Lee's last wish should be granted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants and approves the request of the late Johnny Lee to be buried in the Whiteriver Cemetery in the Guenther family plot.

The foregoing resolution was on June 6, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of SEVEN for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16, of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984)
