RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Doreen Ethelbah, has come before the Tribal Council and requested approval to purchase a home situated on Hondah Homesite 81 A presently owned by non-tribal member, George Henderson; and
- WHEREAS, Doreen Ethelbah advises the Tribal Council that she has made application for a loan with Revolving Credit to purchase the home from Mr. Henderson but that her application cannot be processed unless she can provide proof that the Tribal Council has or will approve the purchase of the Hondah Homesite; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Ms. Ethelbah should be granted approval to purchase Hondah Homesite 81 A.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants authorization and approval to tribal member, Doreen Ethelbah, to purchase Hondah Homesite 81 A from Mr. George Henderson.

The foregoing resolution was on June 6, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SIX</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
