- WHEREAS, Mathias and Marilyn (Hume) Miller and family have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of October 19-21, 1990; and
- WHEREAS, Dan and Lydia (Foster) Butterfield have been chosen as Godparents and they have accepted the role; and
- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at Whiteriver.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mathias and Marilyn (Hume) Miller, Sponsors, and Dan and Lydia (Foster) Butterfield, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of October 19-21, 1990, at Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of $\underline{\text{six}}$ for and $\underline{\text{zero}}$ against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
