RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Homer and Ramona Beatty and family have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of July 27-29, 1990; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Dena Massey has been chosen as Godparent and she has accepted the role; and
- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at Carrizo.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Homer and Ramona Beatty, Sponsor, and Mrs. Dena Massey, Godparent to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of July 27-29, 1990, at Carrizo.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 20, 1990</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
