RESOULUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is the governing body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to apply for Vocational Training Grant for fisical year 1991 and each year thereafter from the U.S. Office of Education, Washington, D.C.; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has authorized the Vocational Skill Center Director to develop, plan, negotiate, execute and administer any such grants and/or any amendments thereto; and
- WHEREAS, the authority granted under this resolution to the Vocational Skill Center Director shall run concurrent with the term of the fiscal year 1991 and each succeeding year thereafter.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Vocational Skill Center Director is hereby authorized to plan, develop, negotiate, execute and administer the grants discussed herein.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman and his in absence, the Vice Chairman are hereby authorized and directed to sign the proposed grant for FY 90-91 and for each year thereafter any Vocational Training Programs.

The foregoing resolution was on July 11, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for and <u>ZERO</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
