

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache has contracted with the Department of Economic Security, Family Assistance Administration providing food stamp delivery services since 1980; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has submitted a proposal for FY 90-91 (July 1, 1990 - June 30, 1991); and
- WHEREAS, the Food Stamp Issuance Program has always been in good standing with the Department of Economic Security, Family Assistance Administration; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has received confirmation that the signing of Department of Economic Security contracts have been delayed, but will be retroactive to July 1, 1990.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the Food Stamp Program to incur normal operating costs until such times that the signed contracts are returned, not to exceed 30 days.

The foregoing resolution was on JULY 12, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to Authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1' (i) (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
