WHEREAS, Mr. Velas Quade from the White Mountain Communications, has come before the Tribal Council addressing the Tribes eligibility to submit a bid for a radio maintenance contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that a bid for a radio maintenance contract should be submitted.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
Tribe that it hereby authorizes Velas Quade on behalf
of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to submit a bid for
the radio maintenance contract advertised by the
Bureau of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 12, 1990</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
