RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member Rubert Lupe has come before the Tribal Council requesting feral horse permit to allow him to trap, corral and dispose of feral horses on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for a period of one (1) year; and
- WHEREAS, Rubert Lupe has prior experience and demonstrated knowledge and has proven to be conscientious in the trapping of feral horses and their disposal to either rightful owners or other uses; and
- Mr. Lupe advises the Tribal Council that he will submit WHEREAS, reports to the Tribal Council as to how many horses he trapped and he will make know publicly this has information in the event that persons may wish to identify and claim certain horses as their own.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission for a period of one (1) year from the date of this resolution, to Rubert Lupe to trap feral horses within the exterior boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation .
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs Mr. Lupe to provide written reports to the Tribal Council as to how many horses he has trapped, their description, and that he has advertised to the general public information about the number of horses he has trapped and their description to give the public ample time to identify any horses that might belong to them, prior to their disposal or use by Mr. Lupe.

The foregoing resolution was on August 1, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (f) (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
