


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, tribal member Fred Banashley, III, son of Fred Banashley, Jr., and Phyllis (Johnson) Banashley, has formerly requested that his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that he may become eligible for enrollment in the Tribe of his mother which is the Salt River Pima-Maricopa Tribe of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights were read and signed by Fred Banashley, III, in the presence of the Court Clerk on July 25, 1990, and notarized by the Court Clerk Glenda Ethelbah and are attached hereto.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the Tribal relinquishment-request of Fred Banashley, III and his tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is granted relinquished this date.

The foregoing resolution was on August 01, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.-984).
