RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Breezy Johnson, Sr., President of the Canyon Day Livestock Association has come before the Tribal Council and advised that the Board of Directors of the General Livestock Association has recommended the Canyon Day Livestock Association use and share the Cibecue Livestock Association's summer pasture; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised the General Livestock Association has approved by motion and vote that the Canyon Day Livestock Association may utilize the Cibecue Livestock Association's summer pasture temporarily this August, September and October 1990 and that next year Canyon Day Livestock Association may use the Sheep Cienega pasture; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is requested to approve the action taken by the General Livestock Association.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
Tribe that it hereby approves the action of the Board
of Directors of the General Livestock Association to
allow the Canyon Day Livestock Association to use the
Cibecue Livestock Association's summer pasture during
August, September and October 1990 and the Sheep
Cienega pasture for one year beginning January 1991

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
