RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal council is advised that tribal member Billy Kane is scheduled for a kidney transplant operation in Phoenix and will receive a kidney from his son, Steven, who is the most suitable donor; and
- WHEREAS, the immediate families of Billy and Steven Kane will be providing support to Billy and Steven Kane before, during and after the operation; and
- WHEREAS, Susan Oliver, a social worker with the Indian Health Service, has advised the Tribal Council that financial assistance is necessary to provide room and board for a period of ten days for the families of Billy and Steven Kane; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Oliver estimates that \$705.60 is needed for rooms, and approximately \$600.00 for meals; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the request for financial assistance to provide room and board for the attending families during the kidney transplant operation should be granted.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appropriates the sum of \$1,305.60 for the purpose of assisting the immediate families of Billy and Steven Kane for their room and board while they are in attendance during the kidney transplant operation and convalescent period therefore.

The foregoing resolution was on August 8, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (k) (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
