- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache believes it to be in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to be represented on the Sherman Indian School Board; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council hereby expresses its appreciation to present School Board Member Anthony Declay, who has represented the interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe on said Board; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Council Member Johnny Endfield meets the requirements of Board membership and can adequately represent the interests of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby expresses its appreciation to
 Anthony Declay for his past representation of the
 White Mountain Apache Tribe on the Sherman Indian
 School Board.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby appoints Council Member Johnny Endfield to serve on the Sherman Indian School Board, and if he is unable to serve, that Yvonna Redsteer serve as an alternate.

The foregoing resolution was on August 8, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.-984).
