- WHEREAS, Tribal Council Member, Randall Massey, Jr., has requested that the Tribal Council recognize and designate the Turkey Creek Community Recreation Area and the East Fork Community Recreation Area as general use recreation areas utilized by the people living in those respective communities; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Massey advises the Tribal Council that he has legal descriptions of the recreation areas used by both communities and that these areas have a long history of being used by those communities as recreation areas; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is well aware that said communities have historically used the recreation areas described by Mr. Massey and more specifically outlined in the legal descriptions attached to this resolution and incorporated by resolution herein; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that the recreation areas utilized by the Turkey Creek Community and East Fork Community should be acknowledged and designated as general use recreation areas for those communities.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby acknowledges, recognizes, and designates the Turkey Creek Community Recreation Area and the East Fork Community Recreation Area as general recreation areas for those communities as more particularly described in the legal descriptions attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.


