

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Ernestine (Cody) Begay has come before the Tribal Council on behalf of her daughter Mandy, who presently attends Exeter Preparatory School, with a request for \$1,000 in educational assistance; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Begay advises the Tribal Council that her daughter, Mandy is on a tuition, room and board, scholarship, but that she needs an additional \$1,000 in aid in order to return to Exeter and continue her studies; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Mrs. Begay's request should be granted if the monies are available from the Tribal Education budget; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council does not have sufficient information with such short notice to determine if funds are available in the Tribal Education Budget to grant Mrs. Begay's request for her daughter Mandy, and therefore, grants said request, provided that such funds are available in the Tribal Educational budget.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mrs. Begay on behalf of her daughter Mandy, for \$1,000 in education assistance monies, provided that said funds are available from the Tribal Education grant and scholarship budget.

The foregoing resolution was on September 5, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of five for and three against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
