

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, in order to establish appropriate road priority projects for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, the Tribal Council concludes that a Roads Committee should be appointed; and

WHEREAS, Rudy Walker, Dennis Massey, Kino Kane, Raymus Albert, Nashley Tessay, and Harry Stover, Jr. as an alternate, have been nominated for the Road Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that the nominees are well qualified and that the Tribal Council will benefit by their appointment to the Roads Committee.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints the following persons to the Tribal Roads Committee:

The foregoing resolution was on September 12, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
