WHEREAS, the necessary documents of relinquishment of headright were read and signed by Eileen (Beatty) Navakuku, in the presence of a Notary Public and are attached hereto.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the tribal relinquishment request of Eileen (Beatty) Navakuku, and her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby relinquished this date.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 13, 1990</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
