

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised by Mr. Ramon Riley, Director of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Labor Relations Department that some confusion has arisen since the Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO) was renamed the Labor Relations Department; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Riley advises that most tribes have retained that the Tribal Employment Rights Office designation and that contractors are familiar with the requirements of Tribal Employment Rights Offices and therefore Mr. Riley requests that the Tribal Council change his department's name back to TERO; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees and concurs with Mr. Riley's request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby changes the name of the White Mountain Apache Labor Relations Department back to White Mountain Apache Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO).


