- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it 'hereby appoints Glen Cromwell, Justin Williams, Marjorie Quade, Jerry Gloshay, Sr., Althea Gloshay and Lowell Walker (Alternate) to serve as TERO Commissioners until further notice or until the expiration of their terms.
