RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has set the allowable cut for fiscal year 1990/1991 at 75.2 million board feet; and

WHEREAS, Fort Apache Timber Company has logged 34.5 million board feet as of the end of September, 1990, thereby leaving 40.7 million board feet to log during the remaining period in which there are two to four months when log hauling is not possible due to unsuitable winter and spring road conditions; and

WHEREAS, it would be prudent to provide some timber that can be logged in the spring when other areas cannot be logged; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that an area with approximately four million board feet of virgin timber south of Long Tom Canyon could be logged in the spring if permission is granted for FATCO to build necessary logging roads into the area this fall; and

WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee has unanimously approved the above proposal.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to the Fort Apache Timber Company to build necessary logging roads this fall in an area of virgin timber south of Long Tom Canyon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that other aspects, such as marking and logging in this area, must first receive a complete review by the Natural Resources Committee and approval of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council before any logging activity commences, except for the aforementioned road construction authorized herein.

The foregoing resolution was on October 11, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
