

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilmember Herbert Tate has requested that public telephones be centrally located in the community of China Town and Cradle Board location for the convenience of members of the public; and

WHEREAS, other Council representatives has suggested that public telephones also be installed in Upper Carrizo Community, inside Cibecue Community Complex, and inside the Cibecue Gymnasium; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees with these recommendations.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the installation of the public telephones in the communities of China Town, Cradle Board, Upper Carrizo, inside the Cibecue Community Complex, and inside the Cibecue Gymnasium.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that arrangements with Contel Telephone Company shall be coordinated by the Chairman's Office with the assistance of the respective Council Members where the telephones are to be located.

The foregoing resolution was on October 16, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
