## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilman Kino Kane has come before the Tribal Council and requested that \$700.00 be appropriated from Carrizo Land Claim Funds to sponsor a community Thanksgiving dinner and to pay for electrical bills of the community building; and
- WHEREAS, Councilman Kino Kane explained to the Tribal Council that \$300.00 of the \$700.00 would be set aside for a Thanksgiving dinner and that the balance of \$400.00 would be placed in a bank account to pay for electrical bills of the community building; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Mr. Kane's request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a request of the Carrizo Community to use \$700.00 of Carrizo Land Claim Funds to sponsor a Thanksgiving dinner for \$300.00, with the balance of \$400.00 to be placed in a bank account to pay electrical bills for the community building.

The foregoing resolution was on November 9, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
