

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, pursuant to prior Tribal Council Resolution No. 10-90-233, the Tribal Council directed that the Tribal Council Secretary post a proposed ordinance providing for elderly and incapacitated adult protection; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that said proposal ordinance was posted in accordance with the requirements of the Tribal Constitution for a period of at least ten days in each district for purposes of obtaining public comment; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there is widespread support for passage of said ordinance in the form and content posted in each district; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that said ordinances should be enacted this date.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts Ordinance No. 161 as Chapter 15 of the White Mountain Apache Health and Safety Code effective this date.


The foregoing resolution was on November 9, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a)(g)(u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
