## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to amend Chapter 13 of the Health and Safety Code entitled Sunrise Park Trespass Regulations and Chapter 14 of the Health and Safety Code entitled Ski Safety and Liability in the form and content attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Constitution requires that any ordinances or amendments thereto be posted in each district for public comment for at least ten days; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed said proposed amendments to Chapter 13 and Chapter 14 of the Health and Safety Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and concludes that said amendments should be posted for public comment in accordance with the requirements of the Tribal Constitution.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Council Secretary to post proposed amendments to Chapter 13 and Chapter 14 of the Tribal Health and Safety Code in each district for a period of at least ten days.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>November 9, 1990</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) (h) (i) (q) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
