RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the importance of Higher Education for it's tribal members and the community; and
- WHEREAS, the Higher Education and Employment Assistance Programs are committed to helping students prepare for college through financial aid and counseling; and
- WHEREAS, these two programs propose that the Tribal Council proclaim December 17-21, 1990, as "Career Awareness Week" for the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, these two programs propose that the theme for Career Awareness Week be "Old Traditions New Challenges, Apaches Challenging Education in the 1990's".
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby supports the efforts of the Higher Education and Employment Assistance Programs by proclaiming December 17-21, 1990 as "Career Awareness Week" for tribal members.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council proclaims the statement "Old Traditions New Challenges, Apaches Challenging Education in the 1990's" as the theme for this event.

The foregoing resolution was on November 9, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
