## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe WHEREAS, is the Governing Body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- the Tribal Council desires to recontract for Fiscal WHEREAS, Year 1991 and each year thereafter for Health Authority Management Unit, Health Education, Community Health Representatives, Residential Alcohol Treatment Program, Emergency Medical Services, Mental Health Services, Aftercare Program; and
- WHEREAS, the P.L. 93-638 Indian Health Service contracts have, in the past, been successfully administered; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has authorized the Tribal Health Authority Director to develop, plan, negotiate, execute and administer the contracts and/or any amendments
- the authority granted under this resolution to the Tribal Health Authority Director is to run concurrent WHEREAS, with the term of the Contract May 1, 1991 to April 30, 1992, and each succeeding year thereafter.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Health Authority Director is hereby authorized to plan, develop, and submit Contract Proposals for programs discussed herein.
- FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White BE IT Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman, or in absence, the Vice Chairman, is authorized and directed to sign the negotiated Health Authority Contracts for the FY 92 for the following programs:
  - Health Authority Management Unit 1.
  - 2. Health Education
  - Community Health Representatives 3.
  - Residential Alcohol Treatment Programs 4. 5.
  - Emergency Medical Services
  - 6. Mental Health Services
  - 7. Aftercare Program

The foregoing resolution was on November 21, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
