


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, Tribal Council Resolution No. 06-89-148, passed June, 1989 designated the Hurricane Logging Unit as a wildlife area and that all logging be deferred in said unit for four years; and
- WHEREAS, a portion of the Hurricane Logging unit that was not included in the original described unit has a ponderosa pine and mixed conifer timber type which is declining in health and experiencing substantial mortality; and
- WHEREAS, said portion is depicted in the attached map; and
- WHEREAS, introduction of a portion of the unit back into the reservation's timber base will lengthen the current logging cycle and annual allowable cut slightly; and
- WHEREAS, wildlife can be given greater than normal consideration in planning use of that portion of the unit; and
- WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee has recommended the foregoing proposal for consideration by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the boundary of the Hurricane Logging Unit be revised as indicated on the attached map to include the previously excluded area.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the restriction stated in Resolution No. 06-89-148 not apply to the area beyond the revised boundary.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the portion beyond the revised boundary be planned for timber harvest, but with strong consideration for wildlife, fish and water resources.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the timber plan be presented to the Natural Resources Committee for review before bringing it to the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe for final consideration.

Resolution No. 11-90-259

The foregoing resolution was on November 21, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
