RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the proper disposal of solid waste is a concern of all tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, realizing that improper disposal of solid waste creates the potential spread of infectious diseases to mankind as well as the contamination of ground and surface water; and
- WHEREAS, there are several approaches which may be feasible to address the problem of proper solid waste disposal; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to reaffirm its resolve to adequately address the problem.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it directs a committee consisting of at least one person from each of the following entities to address the issue and report back to the Tribal Council with a recommendation by March 6, 1991: Tribal Council Members (2), Tribal Utility Board (1), Tribal Utility Authority Director, Indian Health Service, Office of Environmental Health (2), Tribal Health Board (1), Tribal Safety Officer, White Mountain Apache Housing Authority (1), BIA (1), Tribal Engineering (1), WMAT Land Board (1), Whiteriver Unified School District #20 (1), Charlotte Bahlen, Weatherization, and a Chairman head the committee will be chosen at the first meeting by the committee persons.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Chairman Ronnie Lupe is hereby authorized to appoint members to the committee from each of the foregoing tribal departments.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 6, 1990</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>one</u> against by the <u>Tribal Council</u> of the White Mountain Apache <u>Tribe</u>, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
