## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Community Development Corporation has advised the Tribal Council that several Hondah Homesite Lessees have inquired about donating their cabins to the Community Development Corporations; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal council has been further advised that several tribal members have purchased homes from Hondah Homesite Lessees without Tribal Council approval; and
- WHEREAS, the practice of allowing tribal members to purchase homes at Hondah Homesite may create a situation which will conflict with the planned use of the area by the Tribe and may interfere with the economic development of the area; and
- WHEREAS, the Community Development Corporation has demonstrated its ability to renovate and manage cabins and generate an income from cabin rentals at Hawley Lake; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it would be in the best interest of the Tribe to support the donation of Hondah Homesite cabins to the Community Development Corporation for future tribal use and to put a freeze on any future sale of Hondah Homesite cabins to tribal members.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby declares a moratorium on the sale of any Hondah Homesite home to tribal members unless said homes are removed by tribal members from the Hondah Homesite Area.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby supports the donation of Hondah Homesite homes to the Community Development Corporation and hereby directs that the Community Development Corporation also take over control of any homes abandoned at Hondah Homesite until such time as the Tribal Council determines the future development and use of the area.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 13, 1990</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
