RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, this resolution pertains to approval of the fiscal year 1991 Forest Management Deduction Budget and Use Plan which is administered under authority of the Code of Federal Regulations 25, Subchapter H, Section 163 and Bureau of Indian Affairs Manual 53, Supplement 3, Section 6.6; and
- WHEREAS, regulations require concurrence of the Forest Management Deductions Budget and Use Plan by the tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau requests Tribal Council approval of the fiscal year 1991 budget in the amount of \$531,500.00.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby concurs with the proposed Forest Management Deductions Budget and Use Plan for fiscal year 1991 as requested by the Bureau.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Forest Management Deductions collected will be properly deposited and expended on items designated in the Budget and Use Plan and in accordance with 25 CFR and 53 BIAM.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 13, 1990</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for <u>two</u> against and <u>one</u> abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
