

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilman Kino Kane has come before the Tribal Council and requested that \$1,000.00 be appropriated from Carrizo Land Claim Funds to sponsor a community Christmas dinner and to buy decorations, gift wrap, candy, fruit, toys and gifts for the children and elderly; and

WHEREAS, Councilman Kino Kane explains to the Tribal Council that \$300.00 of the \$1,000.00 would be set aside for a Christmas dinner, \$100.00 for decorations and gift wrap, \$100.00 for candy and fruit, and \$500.00 for toys for children and gifts for the elderly; and

WHEREAS, Councilman Kino Kane also requests that Tribal Council approval be granted for the Cedar Creek Community to use \$800.00 in it's land claim funds for a Christmas dinner, candy, and toys and gifts for children and the elderly.


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Councilman Kane's request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a request of the Carrizo Community to use \$1,000.00 of Carrizo Land claim Funds to sponsor a Christmas dinner for \$300.00; with the balance used as follows: \$100.00 for decorations and gift wrap; \$100.00 for candy and fruit; and \$500.00 for toys for the children and gifts for the elderly.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby approves the request of the Cedar Creek Community that \$800.00 be used from the Cedar Creek Land Claim Funds to sponsor a Christmas dinner, and to purchase toys, candy and gifts for children and the elderly.
