RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Seven Mile Community has requested Tribal Council approval for it to utilize \$500.00 from the Seven Mile Community Land Claims fund for the purposes of sponsoring a Christmas party for the community and to purchase candy, toys and gifts for children and elderly; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves the Seven Mile Community's request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and authorizes the use of \$500.00 from the Seven Mile Land Claims fund for the purpose of sponsoring a Christmas party for the community and to purchase Christmas candy, toys and gifts for children and elderly.

The foregoing resolution was on December 13, 1990, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
