

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Councilman Randall Massey, Jr., has advised the Tribal Council that the communities of Turkey Creek and Forestdale are requesting authorization from the Tribal Council to construct their own community buildings which would meet the particular needs of their respective communities; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is agreeable to assisting the two communities by authorizing the construction of community meetings with the understanding that additions to anything beyond a meeting size room would be the responsibility of the communities.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the communities of Turkey Creek and Forestdale to construct community buildings with meeting size rooms provided that any additions to said buildings will be the responsibility of the communities.

The foregoing resolution was on January 10, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of NINE for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
