

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is recognized by the United States of America, as the governing body of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has given its consent to the Revolving Credit Program to construct houses on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation some of which are now being sold through the voluntary liquidation process; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to utilize the services of the Bureau of Indian Affairs to conduct fair market value appraisals of the homes which are being voluntarily liquidated so that a fair and equitable evaluation and determination can be made for the sale of said houses; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council also wishes to utilize services of the BIA to perform an appraisal of the Sunrise Gas Station Facility and the boat dock at Sunrise Lake for the purposes of determining the sale value of said improvements.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests of the Bureau of Indian Affairs to conduct an appraisal of the fair market value of four (4) Revolving Credit Program homes for the benefit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to conduct an appraisal of the Sunrise Gas Station and Sunrise Boat Dock to determine the fair and equitable value of said improvements for the benefit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
