RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member Glenda (Massey) Dazen has come before the Tribal Council with a request that she be granted permission by the Tribal Council to act as an independent insurance agent for the Massachusetts Indemnity and Life Insurance Company (M.I.L.I.Co.); and
- WHEREAS, Glenda (Massey) Dazen advises the Tribal Council that she has received a great deal of training and education in respect to insurance and will be taking her state examination as an insurance agent in the very near future; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Dazen states she would be selling term life insurance and other insurance to tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is agreeable to granting said request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grant permission to Glenda (Massey) Dazen to operate as an independent insurance agent for the Massachusetts Indemnity and Life Insurance Company on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 13, 1991</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>one</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
