RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Member Gertie Lupe has come before the Tribal Council with a request for assistance in respect to alleged mistreatment of her son at the Alchesay High School; and
- WHEREAS, due to the sensitive nature of the issues presented by Mrs. Lupe and in order to protect the privacy of the juvenile involved, the Tribal Council has elected to conduct its inquiry in executive session; and
- WHEREAS, after considerable discussion within the Council and with Gertie Lupe and the Tribal Attorney, the Tribal Council concludes that the Office of the Tribal Attorney should assist Mrs. Lupe in respect to the application of the Federal Handicap Student Education Act to her son's situation at the high school.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Office of the Tribal Attorney to assist Mrs. Gertie Lupe regarding her complaints presented to the Tribal Council in respect to her son's treatment at Alchesay High School.

The foregoing resolution was on February 13, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
