

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Joint Training Partnership Act (JTPA) Program provides our Tribe excellent opportunities to increase the job, skills and work experience levels of our tribal members; and

WHEREAS, because the JTPA Program was poorly administered during the previous administration, there has been an excessive amount of "clean-up" work which has hampered the ongoing operation of the program; and

WHEREAS, the effective operation of the JTPA requires an experienced administrator that is able to both correct the problems of the past and develop an excellent program for the Tribe's future; and

WHEREAS, the human resource activities, primarily those of the JTPA Program and the Personnel Department of the Tribe, have been fragmented and uncoordinated and could greatly benefit by consolidation and combined administration; and

WHEREAS, increasing complexities of Tribal personnel administration which include; the administration of new and old pension and benefit plans, potential OSHA involvement in the work place, implementation of a Drug Free workplace policy, and the need to update and revise outdated and often conflicting personnel policies and procedures, necessitate oversight and direction by an experienced human resource manager.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby creates the Tribal Human Resource Division which will consolidate the program activities of the JTPA Program and the Personnel Department and any related activities that are now or may in the future be included as departments of this Division.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby appoints Ms. Linda Tani, a highly qualified human resource manager which extensive and successful experience both with this and other Indian Tribes, as Director of the Tribal Human Resources Division with responsibilities for directing the program activities of the Division, supervising all personnel, and restructuring the functions of departments within the Division.

The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of nine for zero against and one abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
