WHEREAS, tribal member, Delaine James, daughter of Valentino James and Floydina (Grant) James, has requested that her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that she may become eligible for enrollment in the Ute Indian Tribe of Fort Duchesne, Utah; and

WHEREAS, the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights were read and signed by Delaine James in the presence of a Notary Public on January 22, 1991, and are attached hereto.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the Tribal Relinquishment Request of Delaine James, and her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is granted relinquished this date.

The foregoing resolution was on April 11, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

RELINQUISHMENT OF TRIBAL HEADRIGHTS
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Delaine James, an enrolled member of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, do hereby, on my own free will, and adult and knowledgeable of making this decision voluntarily, request the TRIBAL COUNCIL of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION, WHITERIVER, ARIZONA, to release me from the Tribal Census Rolls of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to enable me to enroll with the ~~the~~ Utah and Ouray Reservation, Fort Duchesne, UTAH
NORTHERN UTE TRIBE

Further, I realize that I will no longer have fishing or hunting privileges on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; no homesite or farmland assignments, or claim to have title to any resources of the WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE, or monies distributed pursuant to Judgment under the Indian Claims Commission Act.
