## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council established a manufacturing venture enterprise (Enterprise) known as Apache Offload Program AKA Apache Manufacturing Company to fulfill its contract obligations with McDonnell Douglas Helicopter Company; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has entered into other defense-related and commercial contracts within the aerospace industry under the above name and has established a reputation base on "quality" and "ontime" delivery; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to recognize its manufacturing venture as an official tribally-chartered economic enterprise of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby designates the official name of APACHE AEROSPACE.

The foregoing resolution was on April 26, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
