

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, members of the Tribal Council often use their personal vehicles for Tribal Council business both on and off the reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, concludes that the permissible use limits of the Tribal Councils travel account should be clarified in respect to the use of tribal vehicles and personal vehicles for Tribal Council business and distribution of travel monies set aside for tribal council members which have not been expended during the fiscal year.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby establishes that Tribal Council member travel accounts may be used to reimburse tribal council members for mileage incurred on their own personal vehicle while on tribal council member business only, provided, however, that mileage shall not be reimbursed if council member uses a tribal vehicle for tribal council business.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that in the event there is a remaining balance at the end of the fiscal year in an individual tribal council member's travel account, said remainder shall be payable to the councilmember.

The foregoing resolution was on April 30, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for ZERO and against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
