FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Cato Sells Truax and Reva (Cromwell) Truax and family have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of August 23-25, 1991; and

WHEREAS, Preston and Pauline (Lupe) Beach have been chosen as Godparents, and they have accepted the role; and

WHEREAS, arrangement are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held in Cibecue.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Cato Sells and Reva (Cromwell) Truax, Sponsor, and Preston and Pauline (Lupe) Beach, Godparents to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the weekend of August 23-25, 1991, in Cibecue.


The foregoing resolution was on April 10, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
