## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal member Josephine Gass, who must undergo dialysis for a kidney condition, has come before the Tribal Council with a request that she is in dire need of a house; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that good cause exist to place Ms. Gass on the HIP priority list.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that tribal member Josephine Gass be placed on the HIP priority list.

The foregoing resolution was on April 10, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
