

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that a road south of the Lutheran Church in the Canyon Day Community continues to be used by persons despite boulders being place in the roadway; and

WHEREAS, Tribal members residing near the area have complained of persons traveling through the blocked road which disturbs the peace and tranquility of the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, based thereon the Tribal Council concludes that said road should be closed to prevent any ingress.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the closure of the road south of the Lutheran Church in Canyon Day to the extent necessary to prevent use thereof.

The foregoing resolution was on April 10, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (m) (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
