

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received and reviewed complaints from the Tribal Community Support Group for Veterans and members of the Armed Services now serving in the Persian Gulf and a report from the Whiteriver Fire Chief of many problems at the Aday Memorial Hall, including, but not limited to, safety violations, negligence in maintenance and repairs, and general deterioration of the hall; and

WHEREAS, said deterioration and complaints of negligence may be indicative of a need to change management of the Aday Memorial Hall; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that authority should be delegated to the Tribal Chairman to review the conditions at the Aday Memorial Hall and to make any administrative changes in the management thereof to rectify the present condition of said hall and to resolve complaints regarding management and scheduling of events.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby delegates authority to Chairman Ronnie Lupe to make any and all necessary changes in the administration and management of the Aday Memorial Hall in order to resolve any problems therein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Chairman is delegated authority to authorize any necessary repairs to the Aday Memorial Hall to bring said hall into compliance with the Whiteriver Fire Department Chief's recommendation.

The foregoing resolution was on April 10, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


