FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has presented for Tribal Council consideration the BIA Indian Priority Budget; and

WHEREAS, after considerable discussion and examination, the Tribal Council concludes that the attached Indian Priority Budget and Priority List incorporated by reference herein should be approved by the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the attached Indian Priority Budget and Priority List.

The foregoing resolution was on May 23, 1991, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (c) (i) (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
